The William K. and Ruth A. Bullock Memorial Scholarships are for students who are active members of UMCG and are planning to enroll in a two- or four-year college or university, or a technical or vocational school. One \$5,000, and two \$2,500 scholarships will be awarded. Donated from the estate of Mary Bullock. Mary loved being a Kindergarten teacher in the Villa Park School District for 40 years. She loved life, dancing, singing and playing the piano.

The Lucinda Dittmer Memorial Scholarship \$2,000 for a student planning to study elementary education. Donated by Gary Dittmer. Lucinda was a member of Hugs and served on the Staff Parish Relations Committee. She was a faithful member of UMCG for 15 years. Lucinda was a teacher for academically gifted students in district 304. She joined the Illinois Math and Science Academy to develop their math curriculum, and earned her PhD in problem-based learning while at IMSA.

W. P. McElroy Memorial Scholarship \$1,000 for an undergraduate or vocational school student. Donated by Brenda Pacey. Mac, as we knew him, was the first chairman of the Scholarship Committee. He was responsible for setting the criteria for this committee. He was a lifelong educator and mentor and was a faithful member of UMCG.

Yvonne was a beloved fifth grade teacher who engaged her students in innovative learning. She initiated a special Geneva History Study Unit that involved students and the community. It became part of the Geneva curriculum.

The Bob Tucker Memorial Undergraduate Scholarship \$2,000 for a student of any major and **The Bob Tucker Memorial Graduate scholarship** \$2,000 for a graduate student of any major. Donated by Margo Tucker. Bob Tucker was a favorite speaker during words for children. He wrote a book called *Grandpa Tucker's Rhymes and Tales* in 1999. Stories of Sammy the Snake were often told always with a special message to the children.
