WHAT ARE HOST HOMES?

Host Homes are temporary lodgings provided to refugees by volunteers who have extra space in their home. Becoming a Host Volunteer provides safety for refugees as they rest and orient themselves to a new culture and community. Hosting a refugee family can last from 3 days to 3 weeks. If you have a spare bedroom, there's a good chance you can be a Host Home.

Hosting a refugee is a generous act of hospitality. Refugees often have to stay in hotels when they first arrive in the US. One week at a hotel generally costs half a month's rent. Together we can create a better first impression.

WHO CAN VOLUNTEER?

- Must have a shared or connected space in your home, with a dedicated bathroom and bedroom(s) for the guest(s)
- Within a 30 minute drive from a local World Relief office
- Any adult head of household 18+ can apply
